HuTerra will give back a portion of your purchase back to BBBSNCW!

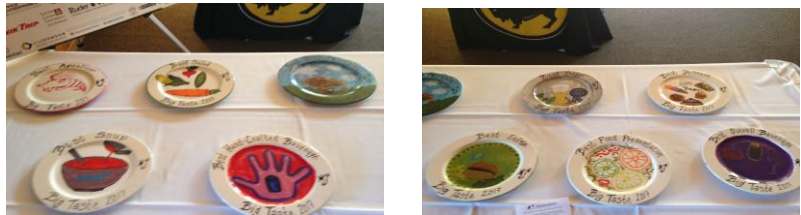

Christmas Parade 6pm

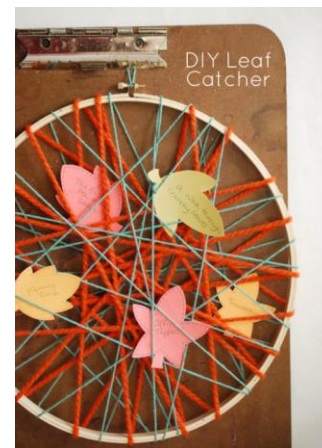
CRAFT PROJECT – Thankful Leaf Catcher

What you'll need:

- Embroidery Hoop
- Yarn
- Construction Paper
- Writing Utensil

Start by wrapping the yarn around the hoop in a crisscross pattern as shown in the picture →

When wrapped as much as wanted, tie the end of the string in a knot with where the string began. Wrap a second color of yarn to add to the design if wanted. Cut out leaf shapes on multi colored construction paper. Write on each leaf what you love about fall, the holidays, and/or what you are thankful for. Insert leaves into the leaf catcher and enjoy a beautiful encouraging decoration!
